RECIPE CORNER

This month's recipe is for one of the salads I usually bring to the shoots for my donation. Please forgive me if it's a repeat since I don't keep a record of all the recipes I've included.

Tortellini Salad

1 pkg. cheese tortellini, cooked and drained
1 pkg. "Buttermilk Recipe" Hidden Valley Ranch Dressing, prepared
2 Roma tomatoes, chopped
1-2 cups frozen peas, defrosted
1 cucumber, peeled, seeded, and chopped
½-1 cup celery, diced (optional)
Salt and pepper to taste

Make salad dressing according to package directions. Pour about 1/3 on cooked tortellini and toss gently. Add the other ingredients including the rest of the dressing and toss. Chill and serve.

* You can add bay shrimp or diced chicken to make it a "main dish" salad if you like.
