Attention all NFAA Members and ANYONE willing to “volunteer” to teach archery at the beginning or intermediate level for SF Archers. We are currently planning on holding another certification class sometime in the late Spring or Summer. We will provide more specifics and a date in the near future.

- NFAA SFA Members will be offered a FREE Level 1 certification class compliant with the NFAA & USA Archery CERTIFICATION program. Those who are currently not an NFAA member must join prior to attending the certification class.

- All current SFA Level 1 & above instructors must complete the mandatory Safesport (FREE) online course as soon as possible prior to year’s end in order to continue as an instructor for the club. Once you have obtained your

certificate, please bring a copy to the clubhouse for our records.

- By 2015, our Public Outreach Program, JOAD/AAA program and private group or corporate instruction must be in compliance with NFAA (and USA Archery, if applicable)

when it comes to teaching archery, specifically to minors. This keeps our club in good standing with NFAA and also keeps our liability insurance intact. We are happy to certify all our members who are willing to volunteer to help teach to beginners and guests. We can use all the volunteer instructors we can get... and rely solely on your availability whether it’s a few times a year or regularly. For those currently Level 1 certified, we ask that you consider getting your Level 2 certification so that we’ve got a healthy number of Level 2 instructors in hand. Specifically, ONE Level 2 instructor must be overseeing an archery line at all times during one of our many events.

Teaching archery brings great joy to both instructor and student. There are many new and seasoned SFA members out there who may be wondering how they can be more involved. This is a great chance to help the club and your community. Please contact any of the listed board members or myself to see how you can help the future of the club.
